6. County Councillor's report
Cllr M Cargill – Speeding data has been passed on but there is no update as yet.
Citizens Advice is to return to Alcester.
£ 2 Million is being allocated to young people's mental health.
£ 9.8 Million has been allocated mostly to road improvements and new Gritters.
The Police and Crime Commissioners element of the council tax will increase to 11.77% but this will facilitate more warranted officers. The WCC element will be 5%.
A rural crime team will be put in place. Community transport will be improved.
The Fire and Rescue Service are operating a hospital to home scheme which was explained and is working well.
7. District Councillor's report.
Cllr S Adams – Council Tax for a Band D property in Binton will cost £ 1831.98 for 2019/20. SDC are increasing their element of the tax by 1.5%.
Dog fouling is being addressed by spraying pavements with a form of paint.
Barclays Bank in Alcester will close but an outreach service will remain.
The lack of ATM machines in the area was a cause for concern.
The compulsory purchase of Wellesbourne Airfield went through yesterday.
CCTV and Rural Broadband are being worked on.
This will be Sue's last Binton PC meeting, but she will stand as a candidate for Alcester in the upcoming Town and District Council elections.
