6. District and County Councillor's reports

Piers Daniell WCC:

I have had a few Parishes ask about RAAC in Schools in Warwickshire. I am told that no school is closed however Aylesford school which has received a letter from the DFE re RAAC transpires that the school has asbestos, there is disruption and we are working with the head teacher for a work around. Myton has been confirmed with RAAC and we are looking at potential locations and opportunities to utilise the new sixth form block, so disruption yes but also a temporary fix until the school risk has been mitigated. Neither school is closed in totality.

Digital Recovery Grant for small businesses is available £350K so please ask any businesses to apply. Wixford Bridge – It is being reviewed today and an independent safety audit is being carried out. £699 Funding has been provided to support the solar conversion for the speed signs in Binton.
